The CMC Lesson Rate is \$27.50 - 35 per half hour session. Lessons are one on one in a private lesson room.

Payment Method

At the time of registration, CMC requires payment for your choice of payment plan. A void cheque is required for pre-authorized debit payments. Should client not wish to pay via pre-authorized debit payments, advance lesson payment by cash, debit or credit card is required for a minimum of the upcoming month, and then again before each future month. Non-compliance could result in forfeiting scheduled lesson day & time. (Additional Payment Information is available.)

Please note: There is a **\$25** Chargeback to the registrant/guardian for returned payments.

PAD Payment Policy and Procedures:

Pre-authorized Debit (PAD) will be withdrawn exactly on the 1st business day of each month at the rate of \$27.50 per lesson for the upcoming month. If a student withdraws from lessons mid-month, CMC does not refund the current month, however given 10 days notice, CMC will stop payment for the following month.

If the registrant discontinues lessons, it is the sole responsibility of the registrant/guardian to inform CMC in writing or verbal notice to management of the withdrawal in order for the PAD to be terminated (reminder: minimum 10 days notice prior to the upcoming month is required). (Additional Policy and Procedures Information available upon request.)

Please do not assume by telling your instructor that the lessons will be terminated. You **MUST** inform the Front Desk.

CMC does not assume a registrant has discontinued lessons if multiple lessons are missed.

The Client will sign a hard copy of the registration at the studio and understands CMC terms of enrollment and payment obligation.
